The Teen Splice Music Tutorial

Here is an online music-mixing activity for teens 13-18!

How It Works

- 1 - Use SpliceMusic, a social music mixing board, to remix a song of your own.
- 2 - Send it to the Teen Librarians at APL.
- 3 - Come to the **TeenTech Mix, March 9, 6-8pm 'after-hours'** at the **Carver Branch Library**, and see how it compares with others. You may even hear it DJ'd!

QuickStart

We'll walk you through making a basic track on SpliceMusic. After that, you can go as far as your mixdown skills will take you! (Make sure you have Flash Player 8 or 9 installed.)

Step 1

Sign up for a Splice account. If you do not have an email address, team up with someone who does, and form a mixing crew! **(Please note this from the SpliceMusic Terms of Service: "Splice is available Only to users 13 years of age or older. Registrants between the ages of 13 and 18 must have a parent assist in the completion of registration.")**

Step 2

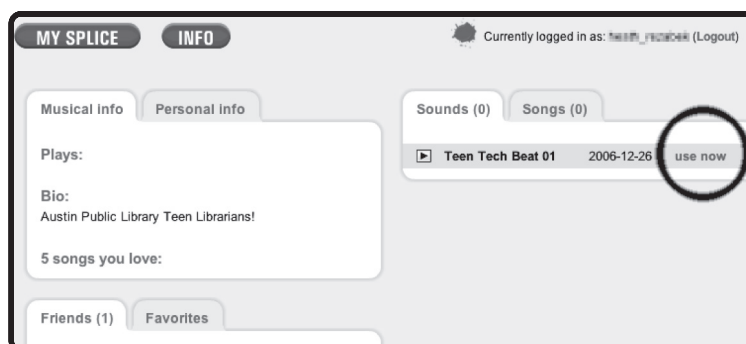
Log in so you can remix. Instead of searching for us, go to this address:
